ORDER

DATE: 23 DEC 2009

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **BRIGHT LAND COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, VILL & POST - JANT SAYARWAS, DISTT. - REWARI, HARYANA** for recognition (HR-1100) for **B.Ed Course of One years (1) duration** under section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE on **16.11.2007**.

2. AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution and the visiting team had since submitted its reports.

3. AND WHEREAS the Northern Regional Committee in its 139th meeting held on 10th - 12th April, 2009, after considering the application and reply submitted by the institution, the documents attached herewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report, decided to refuse recognition, accordingly a refusal order was issued to the institution vide this order no. **F.NRC/NCTE/F73/HR-1100/2009/1023-1030 dated 23.04.2009**.

4. AND WHEREAS the above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 22.07.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi. Under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aforesaid order.

5. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the NCTE, New Delhi, reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal, yet-aside NRC's order dated 23/04/2009 and remanded back the case to NRC for deciding the case on merit within 15 days of issue of this order.

6. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the committee in its **150th Meeting held on 09th - 11th October, 2009** and the committee examined the case thoroughly and decided that the recognition may not be granted.

7. AND WHEREAS the institution filed a Writ Petition No. 12496/2009 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi & the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi directed to NRC to grant recognition to the institution within 4 days thereafter.

8. AND WHEREAS as per the direction the matter was placed before the NRC in its 152nd (2nd Sitting) held on 06th December, 2009 and the committee decided conditional recognition for B.Ed. programme be granted subject to fulfilment of clause 7(9) of NCTE Act within one month. Further, the institution was directed not to admit the students before the compliance of clause 7(9). Accordingly conditional order under clause 7(9) was issued to the institution on 07.12.2009.

9. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on 21.12.2009 in court case Writ Petition (civil) No. 12496/2009 and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi directed that a similar order be passed as was passed in the case of Lord Krishna as the case in hand is also similar in nature to that of Lord Krishna. The court directed that the recognition order be passed as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three days. This decision has been communicated to NRC office through its Legal Counsel Mr. V.K. Rao by fax letter dated 21.12.2009.

10. NOW, THEREFORE, in compliance of the Hon'ble Court and in exercise of the powers vested under Section **14(3) (a)** of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to **BRIGHT LAND COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, VILL & POST - JANT SAYARWAS, DISTT. - REWARI, HARYANA** for conducting **B.Ed. Course of secondary (level) of one year duration** with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions as per the clarification from the NCTE Hqtrs vide letter File No. 46-3(1)/2008/NCTE (N&S) dated 01/10/2009:-

- (i) The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.

(ii) **Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating body.**

11. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

12. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

13. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

14. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

16. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

17. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -


- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND, WHEREAS, the recognition has been granted to the institutions mentioned in para 5 below for the course mentioned against their name:

3. AND, WHEREAS, the said institutions by affidavit have consented to come under New Regulations and have sought for the number of units in B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed. as mentioned in para 5 below against their name, which may require additional facilities.

4. AND, WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have the desired number of units subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure; (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- The applicant Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents, such as, land documents, Non Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) and Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website of the Regional Committee in proof of having provided the additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of the premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution has failed to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. This order shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case and in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc, as decided by the Northern Regional Committee.

5. Now, therefore, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to the following institutions for conducting the under-mentioned programme/intake of two years duration from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions before 31.10.2015 mentioned in para 4 above:-

6. This common revised Recognition Order is issued to facilitate the existing institutions to admit the students for the academic session 2015-16 well in time. However, the individual revised Recognition Order in respect of each institution shall follow subject to verification of the recognition status of the individual existing institution as per the records available with the NRC, NCTE. The affiliating bodies shall ensure the affiliation status of each and every individual institution prior to allowing admissions in these institutions for the academic session 2015-16. The affiliating bodies shall not extend the affiliation to such institutions whose name is not appearing either in the common revised recognition order(s) or individual revised orders.

7. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc, as applicable. The affiliating body

(University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.


8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following mandatory disclosure:-

- Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
- Names of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- Names of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- Fee charged from students.
- Available infrastructural facilities.
- Facilities added during the last quarter.
- Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- The affidavit with enclosures submitted along with application.
- The institution shall be free to post and additional information, if it so desires.

10. Any false or incomplete information on the website of the institution shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there-under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
